

Developed over a period of six years, Male or Female (MorF) is the new, eagerly awaited project by legendary electronic music producers Daniel Bressanutti and Patrick Codenys, along with musician Elko Blijweert.

To culminate several MorF CD-only releases throughout 2002 and 2003, Dance51.com and The Pavement have produced a DVD+CD album entitled *"primitive reflections twisted from sound"*, a 5.1 surround sound release.

Featuring 26 all-new surround sound music videos (3 hours of material), the MorF DVD is an immersive, fantastical environment. Dark, urban and austere giant mammoth megabuildings dominate the landscape. Within this mysterious metropolis exists a solitary character known as "Pixelman." He is an enigmatic being with an amorphous mask of video pixels concealing his identity.

As Pixelman roams the cityscape, he discovers signs prompting further exploration. Doing so transforms the imagery into a controllable menu interface, and interacting determines Pixelman's movements, while also launching the music videos. Uniquely tailored to the music, these videos seamlessly integrate with the theme and interaction of the DVD.

The dark yet trippy aesthetic was created by combining live action and computer animation with futuristic visions from cutting-edge graphic and industrial designers. This urban environment was then enhanced with hidden and randomized elements. With features such as random menus and angles, hidden audio channels with alternative remixes and hidden video content, a single viewing is nowhere near enough.

The DVD features two entirely different playback modes:

- 1) Play - music videos are played either individually or as a complete tracklist, perfect for favorite tracks, passive viewing and looping at parties and events.
- 2) Interactive Play - navigate through a 3-dimensional world, locating the music videos and finding hidden content, suited for an active, immersive experience. Approximately 30% of the content is only available in interactive mode.

Dance51.com's MorF DVD is designed for repeat play, compelling viewers to submerge themselves in its imaginative, sensorial world. *"primitive reflections twisted from sound"* truly delivers on the promises of the music DVD format.
